Under the UK WEEE Regulations, when customers buy new electrical and electronic equipment from Corning they are entitled to send waste electrical and electronic equipment for recycling on a one-for-one, like-for-like basis. Customers are also entitled to send the new Corning equipment for recycling when it ultimately becomes waste. Corning has established a recycling contract with the European Advanced Recycling Network (EARN) and will cover any costs of recycling the waste electrical and electronic equipment on arrival at an EARN recycling company.
